Eastern Bay is owned by Triton Schiffahrts GmbH, Germany, a part of Seatrade Shipmanagement Group. Our longstanding client trusted our services again. We have already committed more than 26 repairs last 12 years to their vessels and we are glad that trusted this project to us. The repair works were carried out for 18 days. The vessel was docked at our Graving dock.

MAIN TASKS PERFORMED:

1. Tank and steel repairs

- Renewal of steel – chain lockers
- Renewal tanktop plating in Cargo Holds
- Renewal container sockets foundations
- Renewal tanktop in ER
- Cleaning several HFO tanks (and gas freeing)

2. Deck repairs

- Cargo gear – renewal bended part of one jib
 - Repairs to accommodation ladders
- ### 3. Hatch covers packing channels repairs, rubber renewal, renewal resting pads and adjustment pressure

4. Pipe repairs – ballast pipe, ER cross over, vent pipes

5. Shafting and Propeller repairs

- Withdrawal of propeller and tailshaft
- Stern tube shaft seals overhauling
- New chrome liners machining to final dimension
- Intermediate shaft bearing inspection
- Propeller polishing
